INTRODUCTION

Abiding in Christ, therefore, means to draw supernatural strength from the presence of the Lord and walk moment by moment in the leading of His Spirit. He is the true vine, Christians are the branches, and the Father is the vine-keeper. Hence, for us as believers to experience a rise in glory, we must learn to abide in Him. This is because Jesus said without Him we can do NOTHING.

DISCUSSION

2. What is the difference between dwelling in the secret place of God and abiding in Christ? (Psa. 91:1)
3. What factors could aid our abiding in Christ? (John 6:56; John 15:7; Rom.11:22; Gal. 2:20)
4. What do we gain when we abide in Christ Jesus? (1 John 2:28; John15:7; 15:5; John14:17; 1 John 3:6)

CONCLUSION

There is no doubt that God is still in the business of taking His children from one level of glory to another, but for one to be a partaker of such, there is the need to go through the pathways, and one of such pathways is to abide in Christ. When we do abide in Him, He will grant to us whatever we ask from Him including taking us to another level of Glory.

INTRODUCTION

Thanksgiving is an expression of gratitude to someone from whom we have received something of value. As Christians, we are taught to be appreciative to God who daily showers on us His blessings that come in various dimensions. Though thanksgiving is a quality that pleases God, it is something that He cannot do for Himself. In P^alm 92:1, we read that "it is a good thing to give thanks to God..." In this year of our rising glory, we must be doers of that which is good for us to enjoy the blessings inherent in the year. True thanksgiving recognizes our total dependence on God and creates that consciousness that all we are and everything we have are products of God's benevolence.

DISCUSSION

- 4. Mention some of the benefits of thanking God. Luke 17:17-18; Jeremiah 30:19-20; Philippians. 4:6; Psalm 50:14-15.

CONCLUSION

It will be a selfish lifestyle if we just keep coming to God for the purpose of asking and receiving without appreciating Him as the giver of all things including those valuable things that we can never see or touch. This year, we must rise first of all in our attitude to God in thanksgiving so that we do not become bunch of ingrates or irresponsible children. How much thanksgiving do you engage in daily?

TEXT:

Gen. 22:5,8; Ephesians 2:8; Heb. 10:38

INTRODUCTION

As Christians, our greatest spiritual asset is Faith. Faith destroys the self in us and shifts our attention to focus on God and the manifestation of His greatness in us. Faith is that spiritual thermometer of gauging the strength of our spiritual life and dependence on God. Jesus prayed for Simon Peter in Luke 22:32 that his faith would not fail. This year, if we must rise in glory, it is very important that we ignite our faith in God, His word and the greatness of His Power. A life of faith is hopeful and will never give in to fear, intimidation and hopelessness.

DISCUSSION

1. How important is Faith in our walk with God? Habakkuk 2:4; Romans 1:17; Galatians 3:11; Heb. 10:38; 11:6
2. Explain this Biblical text "Faith without works is dead". James 2:26.
3. Differentiate between Faith and Hope with at least one Bible reference to explain your answer,
4. Identify and explain at least three miracles that happened in the scripture as a result of Faith in God and His power.

CONCLUSION

Every one of us has faith. Some put their faith in man while others put their faith in their educational qualification, background, possession or wealth; others put their faith in positions they occupy. All these will fail at one time or the other but faith in God does not put to shame. This year as you prepare to rise in glory, be courageous and have faith in God for your anchor to hold through the storms. It is wise to anchor your hope and faith on Christ before the storms show up.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT: For we walk by Faith and not by sight.

CONCLUSION

Suffering is part of God's curriculum for His children. It is without any doubt a gateway to glory. It is one of the tools that God has employed from the ages past in preparing His chosen ones for His glory. If God spared not Christ but subjected Him to sufferings then we believers must be prepared to face the reality of suffering if we truly long to see His glory.

SUNDAY BIBLE STUDY OUTLINE

DATE: 10TH MARCH, 2019

TOPIC: TRUE FASTING

TEXT: ISAIAH 58: 1 - 12

INTRODUCTION:

True and Biblical fasting is abstaining from food, drink or sex to fast on a period of spiritual growth. It is to humbly deny something of the flesh to glorify God, enhance our spirit and go deeper in our prayer life.

Christian fasting is not and should not be seen as a kind of “work” or “requirement” for getting something “serious” from God. However that does not mean that is not important or not recommended for spiritual growth. The book of Acts even recorded that believers fast and prayed before they made major decisions (Acts 13: 2; 14: 23).

Yes, believers should fast from time to time to develop a closer walk with God.

QUESTIONS AND DISCUSSIONS

1. Differentiate between true and false fasting. Isaiah 58: 1 - 12, Matthew 6: 16 – 18; Joel 2: 12.
2. What do you think that link fasting and prayer together? Luke 2: 37, Mark 5: 33; Acts 14: 23; Acts 13: 2.
3. Fasting should not be considered as “**dieting method**” as some do today. Discuss Ezra 8: 21 – 23; Jonah 3: 5 – 10. We should not fast to lose weight, but rather to gain deeper fellowship with God.
4. What are other ways a believer can fast? 1 Corinthians 7: 1 – 5; 1 Corinthians 9: 27; Daniel 10: 2 – 3.

CONCLUSION

The main purpose of Christian fasting is to take our eyes off the things of this world and instead focus on God. Fasting is our own way as believers of demonstrating to God and to ourselves that we are serious about our relationship with God.

Therefore, anything you can temporarily give up in order to better focus on God can be considered as fast. Even avoiding internet for a period of time can be effective fast.

“Is this not the fast that I have chosen: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke?” Isaiah 58: 6
