God will still accomplish His purposes on the earth and in the hearts of men (see Philippians 1:6), but **you will forfeit the privilege and joy of carrying out your God-given assignments on the earth.**

Knowing that each of us has gifts that are valuable and needed in the Body of Christ gives us purpose in God’s kingdom. As we demonstrate the love of God through gifts that He gives us, we can experience personal fulfillment and great joy: **we can experience purpose of God in life.** As we mature in our understanding of spiritual gifts and learn to be channels of God’s power as He works through them, we are equipped to bear abundant fruit in the kingdom of God. It is my prayer that all spiritual gifts lying fallow in this Church will receive divine encounter to manifest and our church will become a formidable force against the works of darkness in Jesus name.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT **GOD'S GIFT TO HIS CHURCH**

**“And He gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry.”
Ephesians 4:11.**

Spiritual gifts are part of the very nature of God, given to us for Him to use to fulfill His purposes in our lives and on the earth. In his letter to the Ephesians, the Apostle Paul clearly explained the purpose of spiritual gifts. God gave spiritual gifts for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect (complete) man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ: That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine by the sleight (fraud) of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; but speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ (Ephesians 4:12–15). As we use our spiritual gifts, the Body of Christ will be edified, unified, and matured; we will avoid deception by Satan and by wicked men; and we will grow in Christ.

The Body of Christ which is the Church is meant to function in the same manner that a physical body functions: “The body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body . . .” (I Corinthians 12:12). The unity and interdependency of the body is an example of how spiritual gifts influence the Church. The Holy Spirit is the one who produces love in our hearts (Rom. 5:5; Gal. 5:22; Col. 1:8), and this love ‘binds everything together in perfect harmony’ (Col. 3:14). Therefore **when the Holy Spirit is working strongly in a church to manifest God’s presence, one evidence will be a beautiful harmony in the church community** and overflowing love for one another.

If one Christian possessed all of the spiritual gifts, he would be self-sufficient and have no need of the other members. Yet God has deliberately given us different gifts: **we need each other.** As each believer responds to needs according to his particular spiritual gift, and as God allows believers to serve Him in various roles of spiritual service, **the Body of Christ can experience the fullness of God’s love.** God wants us to “**know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that . . . [we] might be filled with all the fullness of God**” (Ephesians 3:19), and He is “able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us” (Ephesians 3:20).

BIBLE STUDY OUTLINE

DATE: 3RD JUNE, 2019
TOPIC: THE DANGER OF BACKSLIDING
TEXT: JOHN 21: 1 - 5

INTRODUCTION:

Backsliding is known as falling away. It is a term used in Christianity to describe a process by which an individual who has been converted to Christianity reverts to pre-conversion habits of sin.

A backslider is a Christian who gets out of touch with the Lord. It happens when someone who is devoted to God begins to take her relationship with Him less seriously as a result of carelessness, disobedience or negligence. Backsliding does not necessarily mean loss of salvation, but it can lead to it.

There is nothing like Back-jumping but back-sliding because it is a process. Progress is forward while backsliding movement is backward direction. This study seeks to alert us on dangers and efforts of spiritual relapse and would provide practical steps established in biblical teaching by which anyone in backsliding condition can be restored.

CONCLUSION

The Spiritual dryness precedes backsliding; when one feels distance from God or struggling to grow spiritually. Sometimes it is due to personal sin, unconfessed sin which result to the loss of joy of salvation. It could be as a result of physical, mental or emotional sin. Whatever be the case, come back to Him. David was likely experiencing a time of spiritual dryness when he wrote Psalm 13: 1 – 2. David trusted in the Lord and was restored. You also can overcome yours.
