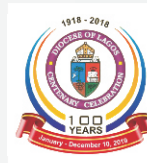

That is the steadfast promise of the love of God for us that never changes. And this is a great reminder for us to turn first to the Lord placing our trust in The Almighty before anything else. Psalm 46:10 reminds us to "Be still and know that I am God!" It is in our stillness and our cry to God that we experience our God who doesn't wane, and is a steadfast presence that truly is our stronghold to face each day's challenges. So, brothers and sisters in Christ, know of God's promise, live into it by calling out to God, seek God's refuge and presence, Whatever wants to sow the seed of fear into us and terminate our joy will be removed today in Jesus name. May God make us dead to wind of distractions.

## **FOOD FOR THOUGHT**

### **GOD: OUR REFUGE AND STRENGTH.**

The word “refuge” denotes a place of safety. It is a strong fortress. A structure that protects you from enemies or a storm or some other evil force. A refuge is a place of shelter and rest from the circumstances swirling wildly outside. In reference to God it means we are safe with Him. We can put our trust and confidence in Him. He will never fail us. The basic concept of a refuge in the Old Testament has to do with the cities of Refuge designated as centres of protection for one trying to escape from the avenger of blood in any incident of unintentional killing. These places of asylum can be found in many passages in the Old Testament (Numb 35:6, 9-34; Josh 20:1-9; 21:13, 21, 27, 32, 38; 1Chron 6:57, 67; Deut 4:41-43; 19:1-13). A refuge is needed when a nation finds itself shaking on the rock.

The most popular verse of the Scriptures used for our theme is Psalm 46:1. King David was a good singer and worship leader. The psalm happened to be one of the very many credited to him and it says in verse 1, God is our refuge and strength. God is our safe place. He is a safety zone and a shelter from danger. David went through several situations and circumstances that could have consumed him. But God delivered him from them all. This same Psalm 46 inspired Martin Luther to write the hymn “A Mighty Fortress is our God.” Luther wrote nearly forty hymns, many of which he composed not only the words but even the music. His most famous is “A Mighty Fortress,” often called “The Battle Hymn of the Reformation.”

On a cold, windy night in Germany in the early 1500s, a young peasant, Martin Luther, came very near being hit by a bolt of lightning during a thunderstorm. Following his close call with death, he changed his course of study from law to theology. His education continued until he had earned a doctorate in philosophy. Through his studies, he discovered that true Christianity does not depend upon what one knows about God, but upon a right personal relationship with God. God's forgiveness through the sacrificial death of Christ became all important to Luther. In battles of life, we have options of who or what to trust. Humans have placed their trust in many other things. Some trust in wealth, health, influence, connections, friends and some trust themselves.

In Matthew 14:23-32 Peter and other disciples went through a calamitous situation. The wind on the sea was contrary and they also saw a personality walking on the sea, they were terrified. Surely, many things crossed their minds. They probably thought they were going to perish. They were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear.” But the God who is our refuge and strength said to them. “saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.” The Word God says to us in the midst of trouble is soothing and assuring. To keep our sanity in this world, we need Him to speak to us. It was after this that Peter requested for more. He wanted to join Jesus on the sea. His desire received divine approval. May our desires daily receive divine attention and approval in Jesus name.

Fast forward to Peter's breakthrough of walking on the water, he saw something. But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.” One of the weaknesses of man is that, we are deeply affected or influenced by what we see. How Peter was able to see the wind is what no one can explain. It is true that God gave us eyes to see.

## BIBLE STUDY OUTLINE

DATE: 21ST OCTOBER, 2019

TOPIC: GOD IS OUR REFUGE AND STRENGTH

TEXT: PSALM 46: 1 - end

### INTRODUCTION:

Refuge is the state of being safe or sheltered from pursuit, danger or difficulty. A refuge is a shelter or protection from danger or distress. Psalm 46 is a song of faith in trouble time. Our only, impregnable, accessible, delightful place of retreat is our God. In the face of so many insecurity, wickedness and evil that are on high increase we need to run for refuge in our God to be well secure. God appointed six cities in Israel as cities of refuge from blood avenger: on the west were Kedesh of Naphtali, Shechem, and Hebron (Exod 21:13; Num 35:11-34); on the east, Golan, Ramoth-Gilead, and Bezer, (Josh 20:7, 8). God did not promise us a trouble free life, but promised to defend us in times of trouble. Many are the affliction of the righteous but the Lord delivered hi out of them all. Psalm 34: 19
