EUCHARIST/MASS/HOLY COMMUNION

Eucharist/Mass/Holy Communion service holds every Sunday of the Month at the 7:30am service. There are occasions when this is also celebrated at the 10:00am service.

BIBLE STUDY

We take Bible Study seriously in our parish. It is the soul's nourishment that all should be eager to devour. This will come in three ways. (1.) Congregational Bible Study. This will take place on the chosen Sundays of every month. It will help us have an in-depth study of the Word of God as never before. (2.) Study Every Sunday- It holds every Sunday, immediately after the morning Holy Communion Service. Members take this in turns. We follow the Church of Nigeria Bible Study Outline. (3.) Weekly Bible Study. This holds every Monday at 6pm physically and on zoom. It gives more room for a deeper study of the Word and all the related issues. The focus is to enhance our scriptural knowledge and thereby develop bold and Bible-oriented congregation and Christians who are able to reach out and influence the world on their own.

COMMUNITY HYMN SINGING.

This will resume this year after a very long break due to the pandemic. It will hold in the evening of the chosen Sunday of the month. We expect to see Birthday celebrants of the month take active participation in this. MINISTRIES AND SERVICE GROUPS

It is important for every true follower of Christ to take the bold step to serve in the Lord's vineyard. It is not proper to just attend services every Sunday without actively getting involved in the life of the Church. All members should contribute to the growth and development of the Church in one way or the other. However, the first thing we should do is to give ourselves and our lives to developing a growing relationship with Jesus Christ so we can fulfil God's love, continue the journey of commitment and experience God more in our lives. In other words, we are to pledge our loyalty to Christ; give more of our time to God, identify and use our God-given gifts or talents, and use our best resources generously for God's work this year than ever before. The under listed are some of the areas each member can be of service to God and the Church.

1. SUNDAY SCHOOL/ CHILDREN'S CHURCH

We consider this to be the most important service area of the Church. We know that our children are our future and we place a lot of premium on their physical and spiritual well-being. Their service comes up every Sunday both at 7:30am and 10.00am. More teachers and helpers are still needed to enhance the work of this ministry. 2. YOUTH MINISTRY/FELLOWSHIP

The Youth Ministry/ Fellowship is another vibrant arm of our Church. They worship with the Adults every Sunday, but they meet every

Tuesday for their fellowship at 6:30pm. They also have opportunities to minister at various times in the main Church. Kindly join and support this ministry.

3. YOUNG PROFESSIONALS' FELLOWSHIP

The Church of God is not only committed to spiritual edification but also the mental and intellectual development of the congregation. As it is the usual practice of the Church to bring out engaging and interesting programmes, in January 2020, the Vicar took a great leap by inaugurating the YOUNG PROFESSIONALS' FELLOWSHIP. It had various interesting programmes such as Mentorship and Business Discourse, Investment Opportunities, Capital and Project analysis discourse, amongst others. It is our prayer that the Lord will strengthen His children in every walks of life.

4. WOMEN AND GIRLS' ORGANISATIONS

This is being led by Mama Yard- Engr Mrs Ibidappa Agbelusi. She is supported by other clergy wives. They have remained focused in reaching the women, ladies and girls of the Parish. They participate actively in all the Parish programmes, fulfil their financial obligations to the Diocese and Archdeaconry, organise variety of programmes and maintain an impressive record in the women's work all through the year. Mama Yard who was the Chairman of the Conference planning Committee for the Diocesan Women's Conference for 2020 remains grateful for the huge support of the Church in making the renovation of Faith Auditorium a huge success. This has remained a great asset to the Women and Girls' Organisations of the Diocese of Lagos.

5. MEN'S FELLOWSHIP

This is a group of men of our church. Their meeting holds every 3rd Saturday of the month at 8:00am where they share God's Word and learn submission to the Holy Spirit in matters on understanding the times, receiving direction concerning their homes, marriages, endeavors and in the service of God.

5. ALL SOULS' MUSIC MINISTRY

ALL SOULS' CHOIR AND ALL SOULS' VOICES

The Church Choir is as led by the Choirmaster and Organist under the guidance of the Holy Spirit and spiritual mentorship of the Vicar. Members have been committed and disciplined; especially on issues concerning their rehearsals on Saturdays and attitude to divine worship services and occasional services/ engagements. Their primary responsibility has been to lead the congregation in rendering Psalms, Hymns and Spiritual Songs.

ALL SOULS' VOICES is the group of people who have surrendered themselves to be used by God to lead soul-enriching choruses and worship songs every Sunday and at occasional services. We are grateful to God for using them in many great ways to be a blessing to His Church.

6. WELFARE MINISTRY

The focus here is on the poor and the needy in our society. Members and non-members who come forward are offered support according to their needs and as recommended by the ministry. Some Church members or their children are on scholarship. This group of dedicated members organise food bank for less privileged members and strangers regularly. Members are encouraged to set up trust funds for this purpose in commemoration of their anniversaries and in the memory of their loved ones. We also encourage members to take active interest in the work of this ministry through sponsorship as they give back to the society and show God's love to those who stand in need of our help. Finally, we ask for voluntary donations from all parishioners in order to be more efficient.

7. EVANGELICAL MINISTRY

This group is one of the life-wires of the Church. Members are sold out to God as they lead intercessory prayers, plan and execute evangelical programmes for the Church such as, Revival Services, Crusades, Street Evangelism, Production of Tracts, Palm Sunday and Good Friday

Evangelical Processions, etc. They meet every Tuesday at 6:00pm. Parishioners are advised to join the group so as to develop and grow in their spirituality.

8. GUILD OF STEWARDS

This group assists in maintaining orderliness, rendering help to worshippers, distributing books of worship and taking collections/offering during our worship. We are all called to serve with our gifts at any time. Please note that your co-operation will be required as the Lord uses them to serve us during worship services.

9. READERS - (COMMISSIONED AND LICENSED)

We are blessed in our Parish with those who have been trained and are dedicated to assist the Clergy during our worship services. May God continue to bless and honour them.

10. ALTAR SERVERS' GUILD

This group assists the Clergy at the Altar most especially during the administration of the Holy Eucharist. More young men who are interested in serving in this capacity can indicate their willingness by visiting the Church Office and they will be trained as they give their best to God.

11. BOYS' BRIGADE AND GIRLS' BRIGADE

The aim is to raise God-fearing boys and girls through a variety of physical and spiritual activities so that they can influence their peers positively. We look forward to setting this up this year with the Sunday School Children and Youth taking active participation. Please register your Children and Wards at the Church Office.

12. PASTORAL CARE

Every Parishioner will be implored to look out for others on visitation and pray with them. We will take care of the sick, lonely and should there be indigent ones, seek ways to assist them. The Clergy will intensify efforts in the administration of the Holy Communion to the home

Communicants. The Clergy may also be ministered to, through the initiative of any member led by God to do same.

13. ELDERS' FELLOWSHIP

Our Vicar mobilized this group of people last year to give due attention to our elders aged 65 years and above .This Fellowship will help many senior citizens enjoy old age. You can join those that are committed to caring for the elderly in our midst, through this ministry.

14. MEDIA TEAM

We thank the Media Committee of Council for the giant strides in 2020. Our Diocesan dedicated the Studio donated by Engr. Gbenga Adebayo in December 2020. This will be put to adequate use this year. Special thanks to CEO of Galant Studio who decided to donate his services to God by providing graphics designs free of charge to the Church in the year 2021.
